



NTMS'2012 is the Fifth International Conference on New Technologies, Mobility and Security that will be held from 07 to 10 May 2012 in Istanbul, Turkey. NTMS'2012 conference is technically sponsored by IEEE COMSOC and by IFIP TC6 WG.
